Total of 250rds to be shot

Shooter picks which event they want to shoot 100 rounds in (either Trap, Skeet, or Sporting Clays)

The remaining 150 rounds will be split 75 shots and 75 shots

Example: Shooter picks his 100 rounds at Trap, then he will shoot 75 at Skeet and 75 at Sporting Clays

All Trap targets must be shot Saturday from 9am-1pm

(Due to scheduling score keepers)

**Sporting Clays and Skeet can be shot anytime Saturday
afternoon or Sunday**

\$75 entry fee

Shotgun Championship

MSSA 2018

1. Must be a current MSSA member
2. All shooters MUST shoot with at least 2 other shooters at skeet and sporting clays (that are in the championship)
3. If you shoot with under 2 people your score will be disqualified
4. All trap targets must be shot Saturday 12th between 9am-1pm
5. ALL SHOOTING must be done by 3pm Sunday
6. We will have score keepers for Trap
7. Skeet and sporting clays will be scored by your own squad
8. All scorecards MUST be turned in immediately after shooting at the main club house
9. No Saturday scorecards will be accepted on Sunday
10. Event of a HOA tie 25 round shoot off will be held, shooting discipline will be drawn randomly
11. All club safety rules apply
12. Failure to follow safety rules will result in disqualification
13. Shooters can shoot any type shotgun or any gauge during the championship
14. There will be only one open class for all shotgun types and gauges
15. No more than 1 shell loaded at singles Trap and no more than 2 loaded at skeet and sporting clays
16. Trap is singles 16yd line
17. Skeet is US skeet
18. Sporting clays will be same course for 100 or 75, but will have different number of true pairs or report pairs for 100rds or 75rds
19. Mandatory pre-registration by Saturday May 5th
20. No refunds will be given
21. Rules are subject to change by event coordinator
